CONSTITUTION and BY-LAWS
of the
SCANDINAVIAN COLLECTORS CLUB
of New York, N. Y.

ARTICLE 1

- Sec. 1. This club shall be known as the SCANDINAVIAN COLLECTORS CLUB, with headquarters in New York, N. Y.
- Sec. 2. The object of this club shall be to promote and encourage an interest in, and an appreciation of, all things philatelic appertaining to the Scandinavian countries and to unite our membership in an organization where mutual respect and cooperation predominate.

ARTICLE 2

- Sec. 1. Membership in this club shall be open to any one over 18 years of age who is or has been a bona-fide collector of philatelic material of any of the Scandinavian countries or is a student of Scandinavian philately.
- Sec. 2. Membership shall consist of resident, non-resident, honorary and life members. Only resident members shall have voting privileges. Resident membership shall be construed as including all persons residing within a radius of 35 miles from City Hall, New York, N. Y.
- Sec. 3. Honorary membership shall be recommended by the Board of Governors to those persons who, in the opinion of the Board, by reason of outstanding achievement in Scandinavian philately merit such honor.
- Sec. 4. Life membership may be secured upon payment of \$40.00 by a resident and \$20.00 by a non-resident member.
- Sec. 5. All prospective members, resident or non-resident, shall make application in writing to the club. Such applications must be reviewed by the Board of Governors and presented by them together with their recommendation at the next regular meeting of the club. A $\frac{2}{3}$ affirmative vote of the members present shall be necessary for election to membership.
- Sec. 6. Membership in the club may be terminated at any time upon written notice to the Secretary, provided the member is in good standing. A member may be suspended or expelled upon recommendation of the Board of Governors and by a $\frac{2}{3}$ vote of the members present at a regular meeting.

ARTICLE 3

- Sec. 1. The officers of this club shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Librarian, Editor and Assistant Editor and three members of the Board of Governors. All officers shall be elected for a term of one year except one member for the Board of Governors who shall be elected for a period of three years.
- Sec. 2. The duties of all officers shall be those usually associated with their respective offices. It shall be the duty of the members of the Board of Governors whose terms do not expire that year to present at the regular meeting prior to the annual meeting nominations for officers for the ensuing year. The presentation of such nominations shall not, however, preclude the nomination of officers from the floor during any meeting held for this purpose.
- Sec. 3. The Treasurer shall submit a written report at the annual meeting of the club, such report and records to be audited by a committee appointed by the presiding officer.

ARTICLE 4

- Sec. 1. Regular monthly meetings of the club shall be held on the second Wednesday of each month at the quarters of the club in New York City. If the date of any regular meeting shall fall on a holiday such meeting shall be held on the first available date thereafter.
- Sec. 2. The annual meeting shall be held the second Wednesday in October each year.
- Sec. 3. The Board of Governors shall have the right to suspend any meetings of the club if in their judgement the best interests of the club will be served by such suspension.

ARTICLE 5

- Sec. 1. The club is empowered to have local chapters thereof in various parts of the world. The location of the chapter, the scope of the territory covered by such chapter, and the delegation of powers to the officers of that chapter shall be determined by a majority vote of the Board of Governors of the club. However, no chapter may be established unless there is before the Board a petition signed by at least 10 members desiring to establish such a chapter.
- Sec. 2. The President of any local chapter shall be considered a regional Vice-President of the Scandinavian Collectors Club with authority to meet with the Board of Governors at their regular or special meetings and vested with full powers.

ARTICLE 6

- Sec. 1. Dues shall be \$2.00 annually for resident and \$1.00 annually for non-resident membership, payable in advance.
- Sec. 2. Any members in arrears for one year shall be ineligible to vote or hold office. Non-payment of dues for a period of two years shall make the expulsion of such member mandatory.

ARTICLE 7

These by-laws may be amended by a $\frac{2}{3}$ vote of the members present at any regular or special meeting provided notice of such proposed change shall have been incorporated in the notice of the meeting.
